- The Co-op continues to grow in members and revenue
- Issued 2% annual dividend on 209 Preferred Shares in January 2021 for the 6th year in a row
- Bought back six Preferred Shares, per our voluntary buy-back offer in February 2021
- Sources of income include: SRECs; interest payments from Willow Wisp Organic Farm and The Anthill Farm; and power sold to The Cooperage Project.
- Stourbridge Solar Project LLC repaid its short-term loan of \$369 to the Clean Energy Co-op.
- The Management Fee owed from SSP to CEC is pending.

Outreach Committee Report – David Pursch

- Current membership is 133. This is an increase of 40 members since last year's meeting.
- We are always looking for new ways to raise public awareness of the Co-op: press releases, events, newsletter
- Stourbridge Solar educational kiosk unveiling and press event on Oct 27. Thank you Lisa Glover!

- Completed installation the Stourbridge Solar Project in October 2020, and became operational (after PPL approval) on December 15, 2020. The Co-op operates it and issues invoices on behalf of Stourbridge Solar Project LLC.
- Working in both SE and NE regions on possible next projects for our Co-op:
 - Lynnwood Elementary in Haverford Township (SE)
 - A church in Wyoming Township (NE)
